

# 2024 Development Committee Annual Report


The Tri-Valley Development Fund received contributions from 41 employees through the payroll deduction option totaling \$4,663.00 during the 2024 fiscal year. In addition to payroll funds, money was received from the Head Start Bingo fundraiser in the amount of \$501.98 for a total collected amount of \$5,164.98. Funds were distributed throughout 2024 totaling \$4,858.00 for an ending balance of \$10,911.05 (this includes \$3,175.00 earmarked for a Laurie Coleman Memorial to be determined at a later date). Distributions included a donation to the National Child Safety Council to provide child safety and drug prevention education materials as well as safety information for our seniors, Envirothon (outdoor learning event for high school students), a donation to the Crookston Early Childhood Initiative, lobbying dues, through the Minnesota Community Action Partnership (MinnCAP), to continue lobbying efforts crucial to serving those in our communities that need our help, and donations to several Tri-Valley staff that experienced an emergency/hardship in 2024.
